5	CHAIRMAN COOK: Let us convene the June meeting of the
6	Nevada State Dairy Commission.
7	Mr. Hettrick, would you begin proceedings, please?
8	MR. HETTRICK: Yes, sir.
9	Mr. Chairman, this is the time and place set for a
10	regularly scheduled meeting of the Nevada State Dairy Commission
11	for the month of June, 2012.
12	This meeting has been scheduled and noticed in
13	compliance with the pertinent statutes, including the open
14	meeting law.
15	A copy of the agenda has been handed to the court
16	reporter, with the request that it be a part of the official
17	transcript of these proceedings.
18	My name is Lynn Hettrick, executive director of the
19	Nevada State Dairy Commission.
20	Present today are Mr. Christopher Cook, chairman.
21	Mr. Troy Crowther, member of the commission.
22	Mr. Bob Fletcher, member of the commission.
23	And certain members of the Dairy Commission staff.
24	Those who present statements or evidence to the
25	commission during this meeting are requested to first be

3	CHAIRMAN COOK: Before we begin with the first agenda
4	item, would everybody present in Las Vegas please announce
5	themselves?
6	MR. HETTRICK: Did you guys hear that?
7	MR. WEST: Bill West.
8	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Go ahead; we can hear you.
9	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Okay. It's just the two of us
10	right now.
11	MR. HETTRICK: We only heard Bill.
12	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Oh. Troy Crowther.
13	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Thank you, Troy.
14	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Mr. Hettrick, would you please
15	continue?
16	MR. HETTRICK: Yes, sir. Mr. Chairman, number one item
17	on the meeting agenda is public comment and discussion.
18	Any members of the public who wish to make comments or
19	discuss any of the items on the agenda are welcome to present at
20	this time.
21	CHAIRMAN COOK: Anybody have any comments, or anybody
22	in Vegas have any comments or public discussion?
23	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: We have no public here.
24	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay.
25	MR. HETTRICK: We'll move on.

1	CHAIRMAN COOK: Proceed with number two, please.
2	MR. HETTRICK: Item number two for possible action,
3	licensed applications, processing distributor and peddler
4	distributor, the Dannon Company, White Plains, New York, Philippe
5	Carodec, I'm guessing, VP Registry and Corporate Affairs.
6	The applicant seeks a license to distribute yogurt, ice
7	cream, sherbert, novelties and frozen yogurt in the Northern and
8	Southern Nevada Marketing Areas.
9	The applicant's prices and costs have been reviewed by
10	members of the Dairy Commission staff, and are in compliance with
11	the agency's laws and regulations. The applicant will be
12	responsible for the assessments.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Is there anybody representing
14	this applicant, present?
15	MR. HETTRICK: Nope.
16	CHAIRMAN COOK: Anything the staff can share on this
17	application? Dannon has been available in this market for a long
18	time. Are they just bypassing local people and doing it directly
19	now?
20	MR. HETTRICK: Actually, they, their application said,
21	I think what they're adding is their own line, so they're the one
22	who would have provided it to the local purveyor, so I think
23	they're just doing it correctly, and other than that, I think
24	it's pretty straightforward. They're simply adding the
25	materials, maybe, you know, the things they listed directly from

1	their own distribution.
2	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: In the past when somebody has
3	added ice cream and yogurt and that, they have indicated the
4	brand name on the license application. Is that required?
5	MR. HETTRICK: Yeah. It's not required. I'm looking
6	at what their, the manufacturer in every single case is the
7	Dannon Company, so they're manufacturing their own product, and
8	it's a whole range of products.
9	I don't know whether this is all new or somewhat, or
10	things are just added, but it's all the items we're all familiar
11	with. Activia, Light and Fit, Danino, Dananimals, Oikas. It's
12	all the things that they manufacture directly.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: Are they setting up their own
14	distribution operation then, so there are local distributors that
15	would either be competing with them or dropping that product
16	line?
17	MR. HETTRICK: From this I can't tell, you know,
18	whether they're just bringing it into distribute it or listing
19	new products added, for whatever reason, to go. You can't tell
20	from this.
21	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay.
22	All right. I have no further questions.
23	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: No questions.
24	CHAIRMAN COOK: Troy, any questions?
25	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: No.

2	questions or comments from members of the staff or the audience?
3	Seeing none, I will entertain a motion.
4	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Okay. I'll start it. I'll
5	make a motion to approve the license application by Dannon
6	Company, White Plains, New York, to distribute yogurt, ice cream,
7	sherbert, novelties and frozen yogurt in the Northern and
8	Southern Nevada Marketing Areas.
9	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Second.
10	CHAIRMAN COOK: Having a motion and a second and no
11	dissenting votes, the motion carries. The license is granted.
12	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Mr. Chairman, next is a
13	Peddler Distributor License Amendment Application by C & S
14	Wholesale Grocers from Keene, New Hampshire, Valerie Leger, Food
15	Safety Compliance Project Coordinator.
16	The applicant requests to add the HP Hood label of
17	fluid milk in the Northern and Southern Nevada Marketing Areas.
18	Temporary approval was granted by the Executive Director on May
19	30, 2012.
20	The applicant's prices and costs have been reviewed by
21	members of the Dairy Commission staff and are in compliance with
22	the agency's laws and regulations.
23	And the applicant will be responsible for the
24	assessments.
25	CHAIRMAN COOK: Is there anyone here representing this

2	None. Okay. Is there anything you can tell us about
3	this application?
4	MR. HETTRICK: Basically what I gave is pretty
5	straightforward. It's just an amendment to add the HP Hood label
6	of milk. Why they're doing that, I don't know. Maybe it's, you
7	know, it could be something to do with shipping more bulk and
8	lowering freight costs. I have no idea.
9	CHAIRMAN COOK: Do we know if this is the Hood milk
10	coming out of California or is this the Hood milk coming from
11	back east?
12	MR. HETTRICK: I don't know.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Bob, any questions?
14	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: No questions.
15	CHAIRMAN COOK: Troy, any questions?
16	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: No.
17	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Questions from any members of
18	the audience or the staff? Seeing none, I will entertain a
19	motion to approve.
20	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: I move the commission approve
21	the C & S Wholesale Grocers, Incorporated, Peddler Distributor
22	License Amendment Application as submitted, and reviewed by the
23	staff for compliance with the agency's laws and regulations.
24	CHAIRMAN COOK: Did you hear the motion?
25	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: There's a lot of paper

1	shuffling right by the microphone.
2	MR. HETTRICK: Sorry, Troy.
3	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: I could hear it, not real
4	clearly, but yeah, I heard it.
5	MR. HETTRICK: We need you to make a second.
6	CHAIRMAN COOK: And are you going to make a second?
7	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: I'll go ahead and second that.
8	CHAIRMAN COOK: Thank you. Having a motion and a
9	second and no dissenting votes, the application is granted.
10	Please continue, Mr. Hettrick.
11	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Next on the agenda is
12	approval of the minutes for the May 9th, 2012 Dairy Commission
13	meeting. There were no corrections, and so we just need a motion
14	to approve the minutes. Mr. Chairman?
15	CHAIRMAN COOK: Troy, it's your turn.
16	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: I move to approve the minutes
17	of the Dairy Commission meeting with no changes.
18	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Second.
19	CHAIRMAN COOK: Having a motion and second, no
20	dissenting votes, the approval of the minutes for the May 9th
21	meeting is passed.
22	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Mr. Chairman, next on the
23	agenda, item number five, staff report.
24	Our balance carry forward at the end of May was
25	456,434.05, that's an increase of 39,105.74 from the end of

Page 10 1 April. Our tax holiday letter was sent to licensees 2 immediately after the May commission meeting, and we should see a 3 4 reduction in the reserves in June and July. We have two positions open at this time which have 5 reduced our expenses, which we actually are budgeted for, so, of 6 7 course, that adds to the reserve. We anticipate filling those two positions soon, which 8 will reduce the amount of revenue that currently is going to the 9 10 reserve. 11 Milk price report is in your packet. The pricing was for Southern Nevada, is supposed to come out today, so it hasn't 12 been included in this packet. But, you can see the trend is 13 14 upward from Northern and I expect Southern to have gone up slightly as well. 15 Our recruitment to replace Jim Bently in Southern 16 Nevada is under way and that will be the new, slightly raised 17 18 position. I'm losing the word. MS. EASLY: Auditor III. 19 20 CHAIRMAN COOK: Yeah. It's the auditor III position, which will be supervising that office. So, that's under way. 21 And James Wright of our staff down there took a 22 position in another state agency. This has happened to us a 23 couple three times. And it's very understandable, because what's 24 happening is state government is obviously not giving pay raises, 25

Page 11 and so anybody who wants a pay raise within the system is always 1 looking to find a position one higher, and they move, and it's 2 kind of a stepping stone system now, because there are no pay 3 4 raises and haven't been for several years. So, it makes it, it's awkward for us, but it's the way 5 it works, and there's nothing you can do about it. 6 We anticipate moving that auditor position into the 7 Reno office. 8 As you can see, for instance on today's agenda, many of 9 our licensees are out-of-state. It really doesn't matter whether 10 11 we do the auditing from Reno or from Las Vegas, or where we do 12 it. We think it makes more sense to have the position here, so I believe we are going to move that position here to the Reno 13 14 office. Our regulation changes were all approved without even a 15 question at the May 30 legislative commission meeting. They have 16 been filed with the Secretary of State, and they're in force at 17 18 this time. Francis and Al are here from DFA, and I was going to do 19 a little report, but Francis corrected me a little bit. 20 understood they were going to start driving pilings, but he says 21 they're just getting close to that, and they are coordinating the 22 last of the construction efforts, and the construction should 23 begin on the plant very soon. 24 25 MR. PACHECO: Very shortly.

1	MR. HETTRICK: Yeah, from that. So, we are excited
2	about that, and obviously looking forward to that.
3	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay.
4	MR. HETTRICK: And that's all I have, Mr. Chairman.
5	CHAIRMAN COOK: Thank you. Press on with the next
6	item.
7	MR. HETTRICK: All right. Next is the legal report.
8	Mr. Goedert?
9	MR. GOEDERT: I can be a lot shorter than you were.
10	There is nothing of a legal nature that's presently of
11	concern. We're pretty much free of any kind of litigation and
12	complaints or anything else.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: Owing to the skills and good job that
14	our Counsel is doing.
15	MR. HETTRICK: Exactly.
16	MR. GOEDERT: Well, if you hire a hit man, it's a lot
17	easier.
18	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Thank you, Mr. Goedert.
19	MR. HETTRICK: The next thing on the agenda is
20	consideration of any other matters relating to the dairy
21	industry.
22	And Francis, I don't know if you have an interest in
23	talking to us about something on the record at this time, or do
24	you want to just wait?
25	MR. PACHECO: Sure. I'll make a few comments.

	Page 13
1	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay.
2	MR. PACHECO: Francis Pacheco, with Dairy Farmers of
3	America. And I just want to talk about the current marketing
4	situation and economics that are being faced by the producers in
5	the last three months.
6	The margins that the producers exist on has dwindled
7	significantly. And what we're seeing right now is, even in
8	Fallon, a couple of the producers there have indicated that they
9	are reviewing their operation to see if they may be exiting.
10	And even though with the opportunity of a new plant,
11	the financial situation is burdensome and, you know, if you can't
12	make the ends meet, you can't make ends meet.
13	So, that's one of the items that we're dealing with in
14	DFA right now is the amount of membership stress that's out there
15	in their portfolio of their operation.
16	And it comes into the timing aspect. Right now a lot
17	of the producers that have planted corn, they're spring crops, so
18	they got bills coming in for the working of the ground, the
19	fertilizer and the seed.
20	So, if your expenditures have gone up because of the
21	seasonal effect of your operation, versus your milk price going
22	down, the banks are not as lenient as they were in the past to go
23	ahead and do an extension.
24	And we have had that conversation with a few of the
25	producers, and that's the reality currently.

	Page 14
1	Unfortunately, the situation globally one of the saving
2	graces has been the global markets, and the global markets
3	two-fold.
4	The countries that can produce milk out there have been
5	producing more milk than normal, and the economic side of things
6	is the economics are getting softer. So you have more milk in a
7	populous that is consuming less product, a fraction of a less
8	product, but we are out of whack on those two sides.
9	So, the saving grace is no longer as strong as it was
10	before. Not to say that it won't come back, but under today's
11	situation, that's where the producers are looking to see what is
12	our scenario, what is our turn around time.
13	And there isn't much to be said about that, because we
14	don't see a strong economic force coming to change the situation.
15	CHAIRMAN COOK: What do you see happening with the feed
16	costs?
17	MR. PACHECO: You know, it's strange. People are
18	saying corn is going to go down. But just yesterday, corn went
19	back up. And there's, you know, it's too soon to be
20	everything is driven off of the corn market, pretty much.
21	Alfalfa hay is unbelievable. You know, so there is no
22	cheap replacement any longer, so to answer your question about
23	feed costs, that's the biggest problem right now.
24	CHAIRMAN COOK: That's where the margin squeeze is
25	coming?

	Page 15
1	MR. PACHECO: Yeah. But it's unfair to say that that's
2	a problem, because they deserve an equitable living as well.
3	The hay person, the corn, you know, people raising
4	grains. The issue is that how does the dairy producer live in
5	this pricing system equitably, and right now it is feed costs.
6	It is feed costs. That's the big issue. But we sure don't want
7	to say to lower the feed costs, because that's going to harm
8	somebody else.
9	CHAIRMAN COOK: Given the drought that we have had in
10	the west, I know production is going to be down for Nevada
11	significantly.
12	MR. PACHECO: It will be.
13	MR. HETTRICK: Hmm. Okay.
14	MR. PACHECO: That ends my comments. I'll take any
15	questions.
16	CHAIRMAN COOK: Troy, any questions for Francis?
17	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: No, no. Not right now, no.
18	CHAIRMAN COOK: All right. Thank you, Francis.
19	MR. HETTRICK: All right. The last thing on the agenda
20	we have here is public comment, again, and discussion.
21	If we have anything on that? And I have one comment
22	that I want to make, and that is today is technically Bob's last
23	meeting in terms of his, of his tenure here as a commissioner for
24	the Nevada Dairy Commission, and we frankly don't know what's
25	going to happen, whether the Governor's office is appointing

1	somebody, or when they will appoint, if they have anybody. We
2	don't know.
3	So, Bob may be back because the law says that if we
4	don't have an appointment, he may get to come back, but it also
5	may be that if we get an appointment, he won't be back.
6	So, I just wanted to make some comments about Bob's
7	tenure on this commission, and the effort he's put in to helping
8	this commission grow and change. There's been a lot of change in
9	the last two years, and Bob's been an integral part of that, and
10	I just think it's important that we recognize that, and thank him
11	for all the work and time and interest in Nevada dairy, and
12	agriculture in general.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: And I will echo that. It's been an
14	interesting three years, hasn't it?
15	MR. HETTRICK: I think it's been more than three.
16	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Three years. Well, thank you.
17	CHAIRMAN COOK: We didn't want you to leave without
18	some memento of your servitude.
19	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: I appreciate that.
20	CHAIRMAN COOK: Service. I'm sorry.
21	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: I think servitude is
22	appropriate.
23	CHAIRMAN COOK: We appreciate, and the citizens of the
24	state of Nevada probably unknowingly appreciate it as well.
25	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Well, thank you.

1	MR. HETTRICK: They have benefitted from your expertise
2	and willingness.
3	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Echo that down here. I think
4	we all do.
5	I do have a question. Now, you know, when something
6	similar to this happened with Chris and I a couple of years ago,
7	they had us reapply, and we, anyway, obviously we ended up coming
8	back on. Is that something, I mean, are you hoping to get back
9	on, or just not sure what they're going to do?
10	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: No, I think my personal
11	situation indicates that I wouldn't want to serve another term,
12	Troy.
13	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Okay. All right. Well, I
14	appreciate it down here, you taught me a lot.
15	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Thank you.
16	MR. HETTRICK: So, we do appreciate and certainly we
17	don't want you to be a stranger. And if you do end up coming
18	back because they don't appoint, we will be happy to have you,
19	and happy to see your smiling face at any of these meetings.
20	CHAIRMAN COOK: And we don't take the plaque back.
21	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Change the date.
22	CHAIRMAN COOK: It's yours. We'll just white it out.
23	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Something, and we talked about
24	this three years ago, I think, about the way the statute is
25	written to where we have to have an ag economist on the

Page 18 commission, and there was some discussion at that time about the 1 fact that ag economists are getting fewer and far between, and 2 about the idea of checking into amending that. 3 MR. HETTRICK: And if you recall, Troy, you are 4 absolutely right. We have the bill that we put in in the last 5 session changed that to someone with agricultural background, 6 because we felt exactly what you expressed, and we have 7 resubmitted that bill. 8 That's one part of the bill, but we have resubmitted 9 that bill for consideration at the upcoming legislative session. 10 11 COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Okay. CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Any other comments from anybody? 12 Francis? 13 14 MR. PACHECO: I want go ahead and acknowledge the efforts of your staff in working with DFA. 15 One of the reasons that Al Trace and myself are here 16 today is we are going to be meeting with Anna. 17 18 One of the big aspects of exports, especially with dairy products, is the spore count in the product. And this is a 19 new dynamic for the dairy industry domestically. 20 So, Anna is going to be assisting us, through the 21 commission, and we are here to kind of get some details down, to 22 get some speakers that are experts in this field, so that we can 23 train our member base up here to ensure that we get low spore 24 counts, enabling us to be a premier exporter on the international 25

2	So, I want to acknowledge the efforts that Anna has
3	been putting forth, and will be putting forth to work with us,
4	and I also want to acknowledge the efforts of your Executive
5	Director, Lynn. We're here to discuss with him the efforts of
6	bringing in more new members and new producers into the state and
7	see where we are and where we can improve upon that.
8	So, I want to acknowledge your staff for the good job
9	that they're doing in working with the Dairy Farmers of America.
10	CHAIRMAN COOK: Thank you. We agree with you, they're
11	pretty good.
12	MR. PACHECO: Thank you.
13	CHAIRMAN COOK: Anything else? Anybody?
14	COMMISSIONER CROWTHER: Yeah. Dave is here, he'd like
15	to address us.
16	CHAIRMAN COOK: Dave Coon.
17	MR. COON: Dave Coon, Anderson Dairy.
18	Yes, Mr. Chairman, I would just like to add to the
19	sentiments concerning Commissioner Fletcher. We have appreciated
20	working with him, and certainly appreciate all that he has done
21	for the commission and for the industry.
22	So, Bob, thank you.
23	COMMISSIONER FLETCHER: Thank you, Dave.
24	CHAIRMAN COOK: Okay. Thanks, Dave. Anything else?
25	MR. HETTRICK: No. I have nothing.
