## **NOTICE OF INTENT TO ACT UPON A REGULATION**

### **Notice of Hearing for the Amendment, Repeal, & Adoption of Regulations of the Nevada State Dairy Commission**

The Nevada State Dairy Commission will hold a public hearing at 9:00 AM on March 21, 2012, at 4600 Kietzke Lane, Suite A-107, Reno, Nevada. The meeting will be conducted via video conference to the Nevada Dairy Commission Office in Las Vegas located at 1830 E. Sahara Ave., Suite 112, Las Vegas, NV 89104. Persons wishing to participate in the meeting may attend at either location. The purpose of this hearing is to receive comments from all interested persons regarding the amendment, repeal, and adoption of regulations that pertain to chapter 584 of the Nevada Administrative Code.

The following information is provided pursuant to the requirements of NRS 233B.0603:

1. The Nevada Dairy Commission is seeking to amend, repeal, and adopt regulations under Nevada Administrative Code (NAC) 584. The purpose of these changes is to clarify existing regulations, remove outdated language, update references, eliminate outdated regulations, and to make the regulations more business friendly.
2. A complete copy of the revisions may be obtained by contacting the Nevada Dairy Commission at (Reno) 775-688-1211, or (Las Vegas) 702-486-8212. A copy may also be viewed on our website at [www.dairy.nv.gov](http://www.dairy.nv.gov).
3. (a) There is expected to be no adverse economic impact on any regulated dairy business or the public. The change will benefit dairy licensees by clarifying and removing outdated regulations.  
(b) The immediate and long-term effect of these regulation changes will be to provide dairy businesses and licensees regulations that are up-to-date and easier to understand and work with.
4. The amendments to these regulations will have no impact on small businesses. This determination was made after review of the current licensee information and the fact that it will be a benefit to licensees and not hinder their ability to conduct business.
5. Since this amendment is an administrative change, there will be no cost for enforcement.

6. The amendment to this regulation does not overlap or duplicate any other local, state, or federal agency regulation.

7. There are no new fees associated with this amendment.

Persons wishing to comment upon the proposed action of the Nevada State Dairy Commission may appear at the scheduled public hearings or may address their comments, data, or arguments in written form to the Nevada Dairy Commission, 4600 Kietzke Lane, Suite A-107, Reno, NV 89502. Written submissions must be received by the Nevada Dairy Commission on or before March 20, 2012. If no person who is directly affected by the proposed action appears to request time to make an oral presentation, the Nevada Dairy Commission may proceed immediately to act upon any written submissions.

A copy of this notice and the regulation to be amended will be on file at the State Library, 100 Stewart Street, Carson City, Nevada, for inspection by members of the public during business hours. Additional copies of the notice and regulation will be at the Nevada Dairy Commission offices at 4600 Kietzke Lane, Suite A-107, Reno, Nevada, and 1830 E. Sahara Ave, Suite 112, Las Vegas, Nevada, and in all counties in which an office of the agency is not maintained, at the main public library, for inspection and copying by the members of the public during business hours. This notice and the text of the proposed regulation are also available in the State of Nevada Register of Administrative Regulations, which is prepared and published monthly by the Legislative Counsel Bureau pursuant to NRS 233B.0653 and on the internet at <http://www.leg.state.nv.us>. Copies of this notice and the proposed regulation will also be mailed to members of the public upon request. A reasonable fee may be charged for copies if it is deemed necessary. This does not apply to a public body subject to the Open Meeting Law.

Upon adoption of any regulation, the agency, if requested to do so by an interested person, either before adoption or within 30 days thereafter, will issue a concise statement of the principal reasons for and against its adoption or incorporate therein its reason for overruling the consideration urged against its adoption.
